They also shared updates on the ongoing implementation of the National ID in Zamboanga Sibugay, explaining its design, security features, and the services it offers, such as National ID registration which also includes the registration of children from 0 to 4 years old, issuance of National IDs in paper form, retrieval of Transaction Reference Numbers (TRNs), card replacements for peeled-off photos, and services for updating or correcting entries.

The forum also featured an open discussion, where participants were encouraged to ask questions and share their concerns. The resource speakers provided thorough responses and clarifications, ensuring that all inquiries were addressed comprehensively.
