

Zamboanga City

Headline inflation in Zamboanga City increased further to 7.0 percent in July 2022 from 6.2 percent in June 2022. This was so far the highest recorded inflation since December 2019. In July 2021 of the previous year, inflation was only at 1.9 percent. (Table A and Figure 1)

The acceleration in Zamboanga City's inflation rate in July 2022 was primarily influenced by the higher annual growths in the *Food and non alcoholic beverages* index at 8.6 percent, and *Alcoholic beverages and tobacco* index at 7.6 percent. The other commodity that also contributed to the upward trend of the headline inflation for July 2022 is the *Furnishing, household equipment and routine household maintenance* index at 2.2 percent.

Meanwhile inflation rates decelerated for *Transport* and *Restaurants and* accommodation services indices at 15.4 percent and 0.6 percent, respectively.

The other commodity groups retained their previous month's inflation rates. These are the *Clothing and footwear* at 1.2 percent, *housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels* at 6.9 percent, *Health* at 1.8 percent, *Information and Communication* at 1.7 percent, *Recreation, Sport and Culture* at 2.9 percent, *Education Services* and *Financial Services* both registered 0.0 percent and *Personal Care and Miscellaneous Goods and Services* at 1.8 percent.

The inflation for food in Zamboanga City further rose to 9.4 percent in July 2022 from 6.4 percent in June 2022. In July 2021, food inflation was recorded at 1.9 percent.

The acceleration in the food inflation was influenced by the annual growths in *meat and other parts of slaughtered land animals* at 28.8 percent *fruits and nuts* at 26.3 percent and *Sugar, confectionery and desserts* at 20.1 percent. The following foods groups also recorded higher increments:

- a. Fish and other seafood, 11.5 percent
- b. Flour, bread and other bakery products, pasta products and other cereals, 6.1 percent
- c. Milk, other dairy products and eggs, 3.5 percent
- d. Cereals and cereal products, 0.1 percent
- e. Cereals, -2.3 percent
- f. Rice, -2.4 percent

On the other hand, the indices for *corn at 1.9 percent*, *oils and fats* at 6.0 percent, *vegetables, tubers, plantains, cooking bananas and pulses at 4.3 percent, Ready-made food and other food products n.e.c*, at 6.7 percent all declined during the month.
