

Zamboanga City

Headline inflation in Zamboanga City slightly decelerated to 7.2 percent in September 2022 from 7.4 percent in August 2022. In September 2021 of the previous year, inflation was only at 3.5 percent. (Table A and Figure 1)

The slowdown in Zamboanga City's inflation rate in September 2022 was primarily due to the lower increase in *Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages* at 6.7 percent from 8.0 percent in August 2022. The other commodity groups that also contributed to the downward trend of the headline inflation for September 2022.

- a) Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco, 8.8 percent
- b) Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Household Maintenance, 2.6 percent
- c) Health, 1.8 percent

Meanwhile inflation rates accelerated for *Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels at* 12.5 percent, *Transport at* 12.3 percent. The indices for *Clothing and Footwear* and *Recreation, Sports and Culture* posted a slight higher increase at 1.3 percent and 4.0 percent, *respectively.*

The following commodity groups retained their previous month's inflation rates.

- a) Information and Communication, 1.7 percent
- b) Education services, 6.1 percent
- c) Restaurants and Accommodation Services, 0.6 percent
- d) Financial Services, 0.0 percent
- e) Personal Care and Miscellaneous Goods and Services, 2.8 percent

The inflation for food in Zamboanga City slowed down to 7.3 percent in September 2022 from 8.5 percent in August 2022. However, the index for *Milk*, *other dairy products and eggs* retained its previous month inflation at 3.4 percent. In September 2021, food inflation was recorded at 6.1 percent.

The following food groups also recorded lower increments:

- a) Flour, bread and other bakery products, 6.5 percent
- b) Meat and other parts of slaughtered land animals, 21.0 percent
- c) Fish and other seafood, 2.3 percent
- d) Oils and fats, 5.5 percent
- e) Fruits and nuts, 21.6 percent
- f) Ready-made food and other food products n.e.c, 7.8 percent

Meanwhile, the following food groups recorded higher increments:

- a) Cereal and cereal products, 0.7 percent,
- b) Corn, 3.0 percent,
- c) Vegetable, tubers, plantains, cooking bananas and pulses, 11.9 percent
- d) Sugar, confectionery and desserts, 29.0 percent
