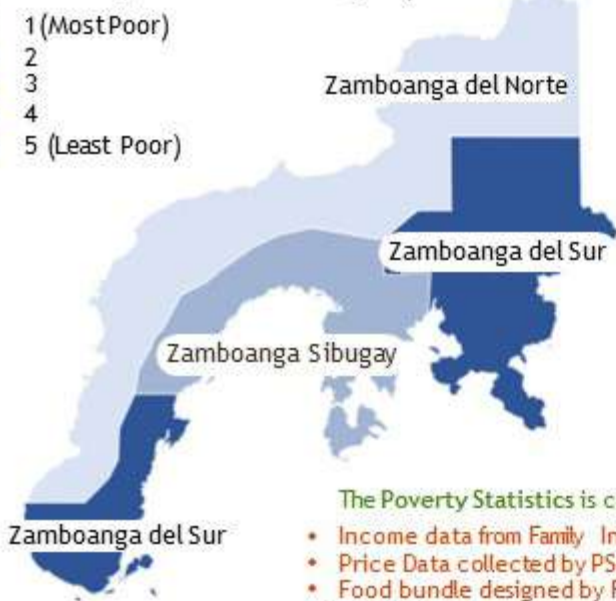
BASED ON THE PRELIMINARY 2021 FAMILY INCOME EXPENDITURE SURVEY

Republic Act 8425 of 1997 (Social Reform & Poverty Alleviation Act)

Defines Poor as "Individuals and families whose income fall below the poverty threshold as defined by the NEDA and/or cannot afford in a sustained manner to provide their minimum basic needs of food, health, education, housing and other essential amenities of life." (Section 3 of the RA 8425)

POVERTY THRESHOLD

Zamboanga del Norte's Annual Per Capita Poverty Threshold as of 2021^P is

PhP 33,799

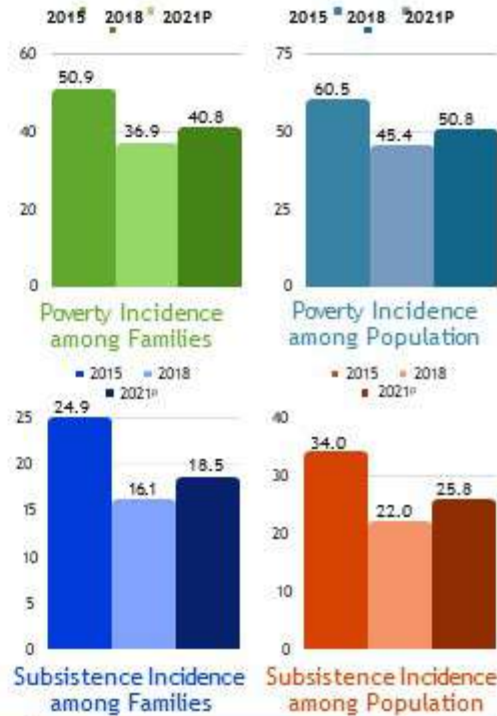
FOOD THRESHOLD

Zamboanga del Norte's Annual Per Capita Food Threshold as of 2021^P is

PhP 23,572

The Poverty Statistics is computed using the following:

- Income data from Family Income and Expenditure Survey
- Price Data collected by PSA
- Food bundle designed by Food and Nutrition Research Institute
- ^P - preliminary



POVERTY THRESHOLD

is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food and non-food needs, also known as the POVERTYLINE.



AMONG POPULATION

In 2021, a Filipino needed at least **PhP 2,816.6** on average per month to meet his/her basic and non-food needs



AMONG FAMILIES

In 2021, a Filipino family with five members needed around **PhP 14,083** on average per month to meet their basic food and non-food needs.

POVERTY INCIDENCE

is the proportion of families or individuals with per capita income less than the per capita Poverty Threshold to the total number of families or individuals.



AMONG POPULATION

50.8% of people were poor in 2021, which translates to **534.74 thousand** poor Zamboanga del Norte citizens.



AMONG FAMILIES

40.8% of families were poor in 2021, which translates to **99.82 thousand** poor Zamboanga del Norte families.

FOOD THRESHOLD

is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food needs, which satisfy the nutritional requirements for economically necessary and socially desirable physical activities.



AMONG POPULATION

In 2021, a Filipino needed at least **PhP 1,964.4** on average per month to meet his/her basic food needs



AMONG FAMILIES

In 2021, a Filipino family with five members needed around **PhP 9,822** on average per month to meet their basic food needs.

SUBSISTENCE INCIDENCE

is the proportion of families or individuals with per capita income less than the per capita Food Threshold to the total number of families or individuals.



AMONG POPULATION

25.8% of people were not able to meet their basic food needs in 2021, which translates to **271.51 thousand** food poor Zamboanga del Norte citizens.



AMONG FAMILIES

18.5% of families were not able to meet their basic food needs in 2021, which translates to **45.40 thousand** food poor Zamboanga del Norte families.
