Gender-based Online Sexual Harassment

Cyberstalking

It is a form of stalking committed through electronic means, involving repeated online communication that causes fear or distress to the victim



Stalking

an online profile which is publicly accessible in itself does not constitute an offense

WHERE CAN A VICTIM OF ONLINE GENDER-BASED SEXUAL HARASSMENT FILE A COMPLAINT?

In all cases

The victim can file a complaint with the National Bureau of Investigation's Cybercrime Division, the Philippine National Police Anti-Cybercrime Group, or the Department of Justice's Office of Cybercrime.

PRACTICAL TIPS IN SAVING DIGITAL EVIDENCE AND ONLINE REPORT

- Take note of the Uniform Resource Locator (URL) or web address of the perpetrator's website or social media account
- Capture and print the content by opening the page in a browser
- Contact authorities through the PNP Anti-Cybercrime Group e-complaint desk at <https://acg.pnp.gov.ph/ec-complaint/> or their complaint action centers
