Regional Director Mewchun WS. Pamaran.

OIC Chief Statistical Specialist Manuela S. Nalugon and Statistical Analyst Reann C. Dela Cruz attended the said conference as the PSA Central Office representatives from the Macroeconomic Accounts Service, Director Pamaran presented the highlights of the region's 2024 economic performance during the news conference. Following the presentation, Director Guerrero delivered a statement regarding the report on the region's economic performance.

As mandated by law, the PSA generates and disseminates the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP) annually, reporting it simultaneously through news conferences in all 18 regions in the country.





PSA IX ZAMBOANGA CITY NATIONAL ID UPDATES FOR APRIL

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) IX remains steadfast in its commitment to delivering National ID services to the public. These services include National ID registration, issuance of National ID in paper form, retrieval of transaction numbers, claiming of Return to Sender (RTS) cards, and updating demographic information.

Throughout April 2025, the PSA continued to expand the reach of its National ID registration efforts. A total of 2,010 children aged five (5) and above were successfully registered, along with 227 children under five (5) years old. This highlights PSA's dedication to inclusive and accessible identity registration, ensuring that even the youngest members of society are given secure and recognized forms of identification.

In support of providing immediate proof of identity, 1,434 National IDs in paper form were issued during the month. These printed IDs served as valid identification for individuals awaiting the release of their PVC cards, allowing them to conduct essential transactions without delay.

To maintain data accuracy, 104 clients were assisted in updating their demographic information. This ensures that each registrant's record reflects their most current personal details.

Additionally, the PSA office facilitated the successful claiming of 99 National ID cards that had previously been tagged as Return to Sender (RTS). By assisting registrants in retrieving these unclaimed cards, the PSA reinforced its commitment to ensuring that every registered individual receives their identification without unnecessary delays or barriers.
